What are protected customary rights (PCRs)?

PCRs are all the things we as an lwi have been doing in the takutai moana in line with our tikanga. They are the things our kuia and kaumātua, our aunties, uncles, and parents have taught us to do, and they are the things we will teach our tamariki and mokopuna for generations to come.
